News

Expanded PIM Management Meeting

The annual meeting of the expanded PIM management group is taking place on July 9 and 10 at IFPRI headquarters in Washington, DC. The meeting will allow us to share perspectives on progress and processes, and set the stage for upcoming developments and continued emphasis on cross-cutting issues such as gender and value chains. Consortium Office Meeting

Karen Brooks, Cheryl Doss, Maximo Torero, and Ehsan Dulloo represented PIM at the CGIAR Program Engagement Meeting with Donors and External Stakeholders which took place on June 17-28, 2013 in Montpellier, France. Donors and partners were generally supportive of PIM's work, and appreciated the linkage with other CRPs and the strong focus on gender. They conveyed a clear message that they recognize the particular challenges associated with metrics of impact for policy-related research, but nonetheless require that the metrics in the form of IDOs be in place.

Project Highlight: Arab Spatial

Arab Spatial was launched in February 2013 by IFPRI, PIM, and IFAD. The online, interactive tool allows users to access data on macroeconomies, information at the regional, national, and subnational level, and maps related to trade, agriculture, water, energy, and nutrition across the MENA region. The tool features aggregated food security and development information which uses open data sources and is freely accessible.
